Head onwards to Queenstown to enjoy the magnificent scenery, adventure opportunities and luxurious lifestyle that the city is famous for.

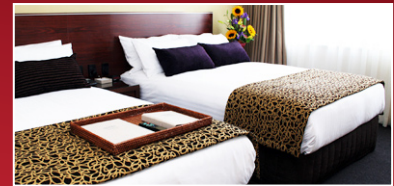
Friday 16 September to Sunday 18 September
