DAY 1 DEPARTURE

After lunch travel to the ByWard Market. 'The Market' as it's known to locals, is a favoured shopping district not only for fresh produce, but for a wide range of fashion, decor and speciality shops.


DAY 4 OTTAWA MATCH DAY ONE

DAY 5 OTTAWA

DAY 6 OTTAWA / TORONTO

DAY 7 TORONTO MATCH DAY TWO

DAY 8 TORONTO

DAY 9 TORONTO
